Wood Innovation for Sustainability with Management & Marketing Option

Wood Innovation students facilitate the creation of, manufacturing, and marketing of products made from renewable materials. Gain the skills to manage organizations or devise new marketing strategies for the global wood products industry

Students study business principles and how to apply them to growing wood products industry. Careers include sales for a wood products company or other business-related positions.

Your Bachelor's Degree (BS) in Wood Innovation for Sustainability



- A minimum of 180 credits are required for graduation; 60 must be upper division (300 and 400-level courses).
- A maximum of 135 credits earned at a community college may be applied toward a bachelor's degree at OSU.
- WINS students must complete at least six months of work experience related to their field.
- Only courses with letter prefixes and numbers above 100 are accepted.
